

Our Commitment to Social Responsibility

Since the inception of our company in 1989, we have coupled our love for great design with a commitment to environmental consciousness and social responsibility. As a result of efforts to better the community around us, we can honestly say that Trikeenan has been making “green” tile since our beginning.

- All of our tile is made right here in the Northeastern United States, keeping jobs in the US.
- By training and employing Americans to make fine handcrafted tile, we are helping to keep an important artistic tradition alive.
- The ecological impact of shipping tile from factories across the world is eliminated by buying American made.
- Building sites within 500miles of our factories become eligible for LEEDs regional points, using fewer fossil fuels to ship them to their sites.
- Trikeenan collects and reuses clay, glaze waste and wastewater in their factories, and offer product lines with 100% recycled glaze and 100% post-consumer and post-industrial brick and crushed glass material.
- The tiles are made from naturally occurring inert materials and unlimited resources like clay and calcium carbonate.
- Trikeenan uses water-based glazes, not requiring any solvents or laquers.
- Trikeenan’s products emit no VOC’s, making Trikeenan tile 100% VOC free. This improves Indoor Air Quality with no off gases, no hazardous chemicals, volatile organic compounds or asbestos.
- Trikeenan ships on wooden pallets and uses only biodegradable packaging materials.
- We have factory stations dedicated to recycling and reusing cardboard and paper; shredded paper is used for box fill and you’ll even get your tile in used clay boxes!
- Ceramic brick and tile is one of the longest lasting surfaces, therefore having a very low carbon footprint overall.
- Our fired scrap is even used by our local towns in making roadbeds
- Trikeenan is an active participant in our community, donating scrap tile and mosaic, bringing the love of art and tile to schools, hospitals, and juvenile correctional centers.
